Subject: **City Attorney Annual Evaluation**

SUMMARY STATEMENT: The City Council is meeting in a special meeting for the limited purpose of recessing into an executive session for the purposes of discussing personnel matters under C.R.S. Section 24-6-402(4)(F)(I) and Section 2.15(C)(8) of the Lakewood Home Rule Charter, pursuant to Policy 3.3 of the Lakewood City Council regarding the City Attorney annual review.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City Council Policy 3.3 requires the City Attorney to provide an annual report of activities and legal services, a report that necessarily contains attorney-client privileged information. The policy further provides that the City Attorney will meet in Executive Session with the City Council to discuss the annual report, discuss any points of concern and develop performance measures for the subsequent year.

To recess into executive session requires a motion, second, and an affirmative vote of a majority of the quorum present at the meeting.

BUDGETARY IMPACTS: This annual review may result in a resolution for the City Council to consider a merit increase for the City Attorney at a subsequent regular meeting.
