Subject: **Revised 2026 and Proposed 2027 City Budget**

SUMMARY STATEMENT: Staff will present an overview of the Revised 2026 and the 2027 Proposed Annual Budget.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The development of the 2026 Revised and 2027 Proposed Annual Budget is a collaborative process that seeks input from the City Council, the Budget and Audit Board, community members, and staff. This study session is the first of four meetings discussing the budget. Additional meetings include the Budget and Audit Board meeting on September 15th and two City Council meetings with public hearings on October 5th and October 19th.

The 2026 Revised and 2027 Proposed Annual Budget was emailed to City Council members and a hard copy of the budget book will be placed in council members' mailbox. The public will have access to the document on the city's [website](#).

BUDGETARY IMPACTS: There are no budgetary impacts associated with this presentation as the study session will be used to provide budgetary information and address questions.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS: Staff recommend that City Council review the provided budget document and provide any specific questions in advance, so thoughtful answers may be researched and responded to suitably.

ALTERNATIVES: This presentation is informational only.

PUBLIC OUTREACH: This item has been promoted through the regular communication channels to be considered by the Lakewood City Council.

NEXT STEPS: The Budget and Audit Board will meet on September 15th. The first reading and public hearing are scheduled at the Council meeting on October 5, 2026. The second reading and public hearing will be at the October 19, 2026, Council meeting.
